<p>LEVEL 5: POSTWRITE</p> <p>COMPETENCY: Reflect on the writing process and be an active member of a writing community.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 5A: EXTENSION / ENRICHMENT</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Compose a reflective postwrite for your essay. 2. Read and comment on two other students' essays on the ECN blog. 			
<p>LEVEL 4: PUBLICATION</p> <p>COMPETENCY: Produce an essay that has undergone significant revision and is publication ready.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 4A: PUBLICATION</p> <p>Publish your final essay on the ECN blog.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on “Blog” on the left side of the ECN screen. 2. Click “Add blog entry” on the top of the page. 3. Title your entry. 4. You can paste your paper directly from word by clicking on the little clipboard with the “w” on it on the toolbar. 5. Hit “Publish Entry” at the bottom of the screen. Make sure that it published. 			
<p>LEVEL 3: CONFERENCING / REVISION</p> <p>COMPETENCY: Participate in a constructive conference where strengths and weaknesses are identified, and make revisions as needed.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 3A: CONFERENCE</p> <p>Participate in an individual conference with your instructor. You are responsible for scheduling this when you are ready to conference and make sure that you have at least 20 minutes of available time.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 3B: FINAL REVISION</p> <p>Revise your essay as needed based on the feedback you received from your conference. Complete the revision worksheet on ECN.</p>		
<p>LEVEL 2: DRAFTING / REVISION</p> <p>COMPETENCY: Compose a first draft, seek and provide peer feedback, reflect on feedback, and make decisions about revision options.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 2A: FIRST DRAFT</p> <p>Compose your first complete draft. Be sure to include your sources.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 2B: PEER REVIEW</p> <p>Have two students peer review the first draft of your essay. You must also review two students' essays on ECN.</p> <p>NOTE: They do NOT need to be the same students who reviewed yours.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 2C: REVISION</p> <p>Revise your essay as needed based on the feedback you received from peer review. Complete the revision worksheet posted on ECN for each peer review.</p>	
<p>LEVEL 1: TOPIC DEVELOPMENT / PREWRITING</p> <p>COMPETENCY: Brainstorm, explore, and develop potential topics by free writing, researching, and outlining.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 1A: BRAINSTORM</p> <p>Brainstorm/ freewrite and come up with a list of at least 3 potential topics for your essay. Write a short outline for each potential topic. Conduct some informal/preliminary research to help you figure out which topic would work best for the assignment.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 1B: PROPOSAL</p> <p>Write a proposal for your chosen topic.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 1C: RESEARCH</p> <p>Conduct research for your chosen topic and create a literature review for your sources.</p>	<p>Essay 1 - 1D: OUTLINE</p> <p>Create an outline for your essay that includes where you might use source material.</p>
